# Janna, Betty & Mary talk about

## Transformation

**Mary:** I believe life is a process of natural transformations. I say "natural" in this sense: We are all ordinary, magnificent expressions (and the experience) of All That Is, and that translates into unlimited possibilities and potential. But what's the power pushing that process? We cannot possibly be definite about anything we don't think is true or know about. It is our ignorance then that leads to all our troubles and/or stops the process of transformation. It is my opinion the only way to overcome our ignorance is to become more "natural" by embodying more Truth of our Being. What do you think?

**Betty:** Wow! Wonderful question, Mary! I equate your 'natural transformations' to evolution and creativity. I think that the driving force, the power pushing the process is the eternal and infinite Creativity that is All That Is, Spirit, The One Mind. We know that nothing ever stays the same, that 'change is a constant.' (I love that phrase!!! It's like a Mobius strip!! It goes in a never ending circle and bends the mind!!!) So we must also change as we navigate this process we call life. But is our course controlled by us or by something else? I think it depends on us. If we are allowing our memories, programs and emotions to control us, then we are not in control. The memories are controlling us. If we clear those memories, programs, and our attachment to them, then we allow the space for inspiration to enter which comes from a whole 'nother level of our consciousness. Then we have choice. We can follow that inspiration or we can resist it. Resistance seems to be painful. (The voice of experience here!) But when change is in the cards, I think it tends to be our nature to resist because we don't know what we will be or what will happen after that change. We prefer to stay in our 'velvet rut' until the pain gets so dreadful that it dwarfs our fear of change and the unknown. But how do we change this? If the answer to this is "to overcome our ignorance", then the question is: How do we become more natural, embody the Truth of our Being? It sounds so simple.... What are your thoughts, Janna?

**Janna:** Hmm . . . transformation, huh. The spiritual community uses the word 'transformation' rather loosely, usually to imply a metamorphoses from the physical to the non-physical (or vice-versa). But, besides a change in form, it also means a change in nature or function, such as growing mentally, emotionally and of course, physically, and that's where we lose some people. When we restrict our awareness of transformation to such an abrupt change as to imply non-physical to physical, we limit our thinking. We are all Non-physical - always; but occasionally we focus our attention on a "physical" form (which we all think of as solid) and come up with Mary, Betty, Janna, rocks and dirt, to name a few, to say nothing of thoughts and ideas. In fact, Mary, Janna & Betty are not as solid as the word 'physical' implies. We are made of the same stuff as the Non-physical, that is, at-

oms, molecules, etc, all vibrating at a certain frequency. And that thought leads directly into Mary's question, '*What's the power pushing the process (of transformation)?*' Since the vibratory nature of these atoms is called energy, we can assume that energy is the push behind the process. However, since we are made of the same substance, i.e., vibrating atoms, that means we are actually energy, also. This gives rise to the idea that there is no difference between that which 'pushes' and that which is pushed. Where does that leave us in embodying the 'Truth of our Being?'

**Mary:** I think just realizing "it's all energy and it's all God" shifts our awareness and leads us to examine the nature of that Energy. Starting with our perception of the physical, we can see it is harmonious (or the planets would collide and our left hand could become our livers.) From there, we can ascertain it is intelligent, therefore it can't be ignorant. This Energy must be creative to sustain Itself. And it must be the Truth because It's nature never changes. Therefore, as you said Janna, the pusher and the pushee is exactly the same. To embody more of Truth, and to take away that scary, resistance-filled concept of "change", perhaps all we need to do is, in our minds, exchange "change" to "growth". To me that feels more natural. Betty, do you think that would help getting out of our "velvet ruts"?

**Betty:** Definitely, Mary! That takes away the fear for me and puts it in a "natural" category that feels more comfortable. But I wonder, don't we *always* "embody" the truth of our being? Because if it's all God, then we can't *not* be *that*, right? We can only think that we aren't! We say that God/ All That Is is Infinite Creativity, so isn't *that* the power that drives our transformation? I sorta think that transformation is the natural order of things whether or not we can actually see it, or feel it. We guide it with our thinking perhaps, or our resistance. Might it be that we just have to unlearn so much of what we have learned about being a human on this earth? It is this veil of illusion that has the wool pulled over our eyes keeping us from easily seeing that we are truly magnificent expressions/experiences of All That Is. So I guess you *could* call it ignorance of our true being. And I believe that the easiest way to catch a glimpse beyond that veil is to see it being lived by someone else. If they can do it, perhaps I can too! When we see someone living Love, Kindness, Compassion, Beauty, Joy... we are inspired to greater heights in our own life. It's contagious!!! What do you think, Janna?

**Janna:** Two thoughts come to mind, both related to your idea of 'contagion', Betty, and to your thoughts on 'being more natural in order to embody our True nature', Mary. First of all, I think that being 'natural' actually means encompassing more of our True Nature which is Pure Energy – Loving, Kind, Joyous, Abundant - Pure Energy. That's God, All-That-Is. And that's what we are – even when we don't recognize it. But the question is, how do we become more of that? I think we have a built-in detector system for determining when we are veering away from our true na-

ture. It's called Emotions. The minute I do something that's not for my best good, I get an immediate "hit" in my chest or gut. If I were to always pay attention to these 'hits' I wouldn't stray too far from my true nature – but it does take practice.! And that leads directly to Betty's idea of Contagion. We cannot "see" something good in someone else that isn't already present, to some degree, in ourselves. So, by recognizing the good in someone else, and feeling inspired by it, we automatically draw more of that same thing to us. It is the All, filling in the spaces created by our desires. That's Creativity. Does that work for you, Mary?

**Mary:** `I agree with both of you on the "contagious" thing, and I think that's why we study, read, discuss and listen to those who inspire us. Personally, Janna, what you describe as an emotional detector for staying on the path doesn't work for me. (Of course, I'm a tad emotionally unstable. Okay, a lot!) My emotions tend to jerk me around so I really don't rely on them and go directly to Source--that place of Peace and Wisdom. From there I can step back and watch myself "twirl" in my confusion, and KNOW it's not my True and Natural being. Also from there I can commune with Truth, receiving guidance, comfort, learn more about my true being, and even where I left my bank card. Again. And yes, It is Creativity. 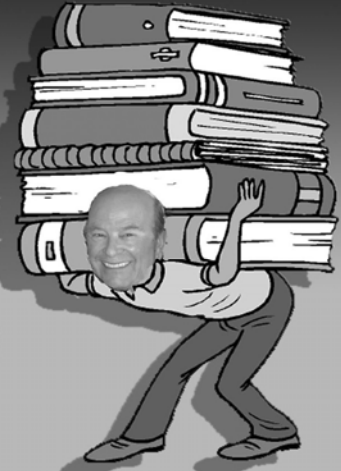

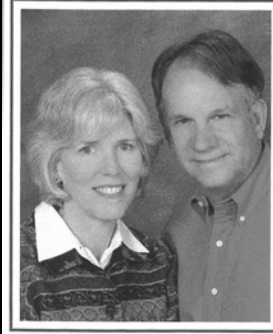
